Carrick Roads Approaches – Charity Swim

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a charity swim is planned between Pendennis Point and St Mawes Castle on Sunday 6th June.

The event will take place between 1230 and 1330 and will involve up to 200 swimmers. The swimmers will start at Crab Quay on Pendennis Point, position 50 08.70N, 005 02.60W and will finish at the beach below St Mawes Castle, position 50 09.27N, 005 01.55W.

The route will take the participants across the deep water channel which is the shipping route for the Carrick Roads and Falmouth. The event will be marshalled by Lifeguards on rescue boards, the Falmouth IRB, Fire service Transco phoenix, Harbour Masters vessels Trelawney and Killigrew and a number of small powered vessels. The Madellin May will act as the guard boat control and will be monitoring Ch16 and working on Ch 72.

Mariners are advised to keep a good visual and listening watch and are requested to give all swimmers and safety boats a wide berth and to proceed at a safe speed.
