### **Awards mark end of busy year for Commissioners**

A man who provides safety craft for events around Falmouth has been recognised for his dedication by Falmouth Harbour Commissioners (FHC).

The award was presented to Mr Ruberry, a member of Mylor Yacht Club and instructor at Falmouth School of Sailing, at the annual stakeholders meeting of the Fal Estuary Marine Safety Committee.



Mr Ellis said: "I am proud to present Chris Ruberry with this very special award as thanks and acknowledgment from everyone in the port for his continued hard work."

At the same meeting, Falmouth Harbour Master Captain Mark Sansom was given a commemorative framed poster in thanks for supporting a school outreach programme at the National Maritime Museum Cornwall.

FHC donated £2,500 towards the initiative, which has been seen by more than 1,000 Cornish school children from 19 schools across the county.
