ARROW TO THE RESCUE

The crew of The Falmouth Harbour Commissioners pilot boat 'Arrow' came to the rescue of three crew onboard a sinking fishing boat 'Lady Hamilton' this morning (Wednesday 3rd October).

At 6.30 am Falmouth Harbour Commissioners were alerted to the incident in Falmouth Bay, two miles south of Pendennis Point. The crew from the sinking boat had reported that they could see the pilot boat from their position and so 'Arrow' was asked to give assistance.

Three crew members were evacuated from the fishing boat and remained on the pilot boat until the arrival of the Falmouth Lifeboat a short time afterwards. When safely onboard the lifeboat, 'Arrow' resumed her usual duties, providing a pilot service to vessels in the bay.

Falmouth Harbour Commissioner Captain Mark Sansom says: *"I'm extremely proud of the crew Mike Tuffery and Allen Stevens who should be commended for their prompt and professional action in helping to ensure that the incident resulted in a positive outcome."*
