Red Arrows Take To The Skies During Falmouth Week 2010

The spectacular Red Arrows will be wowing crowds once again during this year's Henri Lloyd Falmouth Week, thanks to sponsors Falmouth Harbour Commissioners (FHC).

The Royal Air Force's world-famous aerobatics team is back for the second year on Wednesday August 11 in Falmouth inner harbour. Last year thousands of people flocked to the town and took up positions along the waterfront to watch the awesome display.



FHC Chief Executive and Harbour Master Mark Sansom said: “We are proud to sponsor the Red Arrows and to bring that extra special something to Henri Lloyd Falmouth Week once again.

“The sight of them performing so close to the water will be a sight to remember.”

Since the team was formed in 1965, it has performed more than 4,000 displays in 53 different countries. All of the Red Arrows pilots have previously served in the front line as jet pilots in the Royal Air Force, with many having recently returned from Iraq and Afghanistan.

Falmouth Harbour Commissioners (FHC), the harbour authority for the port of Falmouth, has supported Henri Lloyd Falmouth Week for many years, regularly sponsoring the spectacular firework display.

Captain Sansom said: “The Red Arrows are so busy and have such an intense schedule so we were all delighted when they confirmed. The great thing about it is that everyone can enjoy it; be it racers or non-racers, visitors or locals. It is great to have something that has such a wide appeal.”
