WINTER VISITORS MOORING CONDITIONS

We are pleased to be able to offer you one of our visitors moorings for your vessel for the coming winter season. The winter period is from 1st November to 31st March and the winter tariff is between these dates only. Any stay on our visitors moorings outside of the winter dates are at the usual visitors rates.

PLEASE NOTE OUR REGULATIONS FOR USING THE VISITORS MOORINGS.

1. Vessels must be moored on one of the green visitors buoys and not on any other facility in the harbour unless otherwise directed by the Harbour Office.
2. All vessels must be secured to the mooring buoy top shackle with a chain pendant or anchor chain. The hirer is responsible for the provision and the maintenance of the pendant, which shall be fit for purpose and not be of excessive length. If the pendant is fitted by the Falmouth Harbour Commissioners, they shall not be liable for any defect in this work unless notified in writing within seven days of the work being completed.
3. The hirer must maintain adequate insurance which must also cover third party liability of at least £1,000,000 for a vessel with LOA of more than 7 metres. A copy of this insurance must be produced at the Harbour Office.
4. Please ensure that your vessel's safety is adequately monitored during your stay. It is not a requirement that the vessel is occupied overnight, however the Harbour Office must be informed if the vessel is to be left unattended and a contact telephone number must be provided.
5. Any rubbish is to be bagged and disposed of in the wheelie bins sited next to the Amenity Centre on North Quay. Please use these bins for domestic waste only. For disposal of harmful or polluting substances such as waste oil or batteries please contact the Yacht Haven supervisor or Harbour Office who will arrange for free disposal.
6. In the case of emergency occurring outside of the normal working hours or at the weekend, please call 07836 661668 for advice. If this proves to be unsuccessful and the problem is serious please call Falmouth Coastguard on 01326 317575 or on VHF channel 16.

We hope that you enjoy your stay and we look forward to your return. Please mention our mooring facilities to your friends.
