APPOINTMENT OF BOARD MEMBERS (1 POST)

**The Falmouth Harbour Commission (FHC) is a Trust Port, with statutory responsibility for management and conservancy of approximately 16 square miles of harbour area. The Port is visited by ships of all types and sizes primarily for bunkers or ship repair. Falmouth Harbour Commissioners are designated as a Competent Harbour Authority under the 1987 Pilotage Act and manage pilotage for the Estuary, Bay and Docks. The Turnover of the Business including pilotage is in excess of £1m.**

There will shortly be a vacancy on the Board, and we are seeking applications from persons interested in being considered for membership of the Commissioners. Candidates are generally expected to have wide and relevant experience preferably at senior or board level, and in particular FHC are seeking candidates with knowledge and experience of the following;

Management of a small or medium sized business. Experience gained in a Marine Leisure Industry would be advantageous.

Residence within a reasonable distance (i.e. around 50 miles) of the port and familiarity with local issues in the region surrounding the port are highly desirable.

The duties of Board Members are akin to those of a director of a company, in particular to be accountable for the proper exercise of the Authority's statutory functions and to provide proper oversight and direction in relation to the safety of marine operations and the financial performance of all activities. Attendance of meetings is remunerated.
